



FELLOWSHIP

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING FOR FELLOWSHIP

To be considered for **Fellowship** a Member must fulfill the following:

- a) provide evidence of an advanced practical and theoretical knowledge of the Laban system
- b) have attended at least one full Biennial Conference of the Council
- c) be recommended by a Fellow of the Council.

When applying for Fellowship applicants must supply evidence of two of the following dealing directly with their practical and theoretical knowledge of the system:

- study at advanced level
- original notations at advanced level
- teaching experience; responsibility for student studies at advanced level; attendance and lecturing at courses dealing with advanced level work
- original publications or texts relating to the system
- other relevant evidence the applicant may wish to submit in support of his/her level of practical and theoretical knowledge of the system.

Application for Fellowship must be submitted to the Vice Chair at the beginning of the ICKL Conference which the applicant attends. The application must be accompanied by representative examples of notated materials demonstrating the individual's notation skills. (These will be returned.)

Members are elected to Fellowship by a 2/3 majority of votes received from all the Fellows.
