

# Travel Guidance

## From Budapest Ferenc Liszt International Airport (formerly Budapest Ferihegy International Airport) into Budapest City

### TAXI

The most convenient way to get into Budapest city center from the Airport is taking a taxi. It is recommended to select taxi company „Főtaxi”. The price for a ride into District 3, which is Buda side of the capital, near the conference location is 5300 HUF (approx. 30 US\$ or 22 EUR). You can check prices and options here:

### AirportShuttle

However AirportShuttle-Minibus can be the best choice for getting from every terminal (Terminal 1, Terminal 2A and 2B) into Budapest city center. The AirportShuttle provides a convenient door-to-door transfer between the Airport and any point of Budapest for 2990 HUF/person (approx. 17 US\$ or 11,5 EUR). The AirportShuttle operates 24 hours a day, its Desks are to be found at each terminal. The transfer operates as a shared-ride service, which means that passengers travelling to/from the same/ closely situated address are escorted in the same vehicle. Details can be looked up here:



## Public transport

Public transport is also an option – see the map below, stations for change are encircled. Bus 200E can be boarded at each terminal. Bus 200E takes passengers to „Határ út” metro station, where you can change to metro line 3 towards „Újpest Központ”. Those who want to go to Hotel Mercure should change at „Deák tér” station to metro line 2 into the direction of „Déli pályaudvar”. Hotel Mercure is about 5 minutes walk from the terminal of metro line 2, which is „Déli pályaudvar”. To get to the location of the conference or to the Guesthouse in the Castle District, take the same route as above, but do not travel to the last station, get off the metro line at „Széll Kálmán tér” (formerly „Moszkva tér”). Guidance on how to reach the Institute for Musicology can be found on page 4. The tickets for the three/four lines cost altogether 1040/1360 HUF (approx. 6/7,6 US\$ or 4/5,2 EUR). 

## Public transport from the railway stations


The metro lines stop at all main railway stations. On the map below the three in-city railway stations are framed. To get to the location of the conference, from „Nyugati pályaudvar” (Nyugati Railway Station) take metro line 3 toward „Kőbánya-Kispest”, change to metro line 2 at „Deák tér” toward „Déli pályaudvar” (Déli Railway Station), and get off at „Széll Kálmán tér” (formerly „Moszkva tér”).

From „Keleti pályaudvar” (Keleti Railway Station) take metro line 2 toward „Déli pályaudvar” (Déli Railway Station) and get off at „Széll Kálmán tér”. From here to the Institute for Musicology see the next page.




## From „Széll Kálmán tér” (formerly „Moszkva tér”) to the Institute for Musicology

Two maps below help finding the Institute for Musicology (in Hungarian „MTA Zenetudományi Intézet”). On Map 1 the building of the metro station on „Széll Kálmán tér” (formerly „Moszkva tér”) is encircled (all Google maps show the former name), and an orange line for walking leads you the stop of bus 16 or 16A. Watch carefully, on „Széll Kálmán tér” there are several bus stops. Stop for bus 16/16A is in „Várfok utca”, search the sign. Ride two stops, the second one is already in the Castle District (see Map 2), the bus passes a gate called „Bécsi kapu”. As Map 2 indicates, from the bus stop you can walk to the building of the Institute for Musicology, it is about a 3 minutes walk. Those who prefer walking all along from „Széll Kálmán tér” to the Institute, can count on a 10 minutes walk uphill. The address of the Institute for Musicology: 1014 Budapest, Táncsics Mihály utca 7.
